To all residents of Sky Lakes Water Supply Corporation

As part of our commitment to provide high quality and safe drinking water, we conduct many water tests each year. TCEQ requires us to test for Lead and Copper once every three years. This test requires taking samples from inside our residents' homes. This year five homeowners collected samples. One of these samples came back from the lab with a higher lead content than TCEQ's threshold of 15 ppb (part per billion) or (.0215 m/l.)

Per TCEQ requirements, we are enclosing a copy of TCEQ Publication of Lead in Drinking Water for your information.

You may be wondering how this affects your drinking water. Please note that only one of the samples from the five homes tested came back higher than normal. We are quite confident that this is a local problem limited to the home where the sample was collected. There are, however, steps that we as a Public Water System must take to ensure that all drinking water in all homes is within the acceptable levels of lead.

These steps include twice a year monitoring and increasing our sample sites from the five original ones to 10 residences. The next testing will be in February, 2016. There are other steps that will be taken; including Entry Point Water Quality Parameter Monitoring. However, this monitoring is done by our operator. We will keep you informed with regards to the water quality testing and the results.
